	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Must have executive power over the supervision, level of responsibility and workload of the Registrar • Must have a minimum of three years full-time general practice experience (after graduation from the training scheme), two of which must be in Irish General Practice. <p>Multiple GPs from the same practice are eligible to apply as are GPs wishing to job share post.</p> <p>Practice visits will occur after the interview date. Practices will be visited by the Directing Team to assess the suitability of the premises and records in line with the requirements outlined in the General practice rotations policy as part of the recruitment procedure. Appointment post interview is subject to a satisfactory practice visit.</p>
